Historic Preservation Award Categories

Bricks and Mortar Preservation Award

Awarded to recognize construction projects of exceptional quality that have a positive impact on the preservation of West Chester's historic fabric.

Preservation Service Award

Awarded to individuals and organizations in recognition of projects that promote a better understanding of the history of West Chester and the need to preserve the physical evidence of that history.

West Chester Preservationist Award

Awarded to an individual or organization in recognition of outstanding contributions to the better understanding of West Chester's history and the preservation of the Borough's historic fabric.

Nomination Guidelines

Bricks and Mortar Preservation Award

- Briefly describe the project, which may include annotated history of the building before and after rehabilitation or restoration
- Describe any special conditions or challenges addressed during the project
- Provide clear photographs illustrating the project before (if available) and after work
- Project must have been completed after January 1, 2001
- All nominations will be judged in accordance with the published *Design Guidelines for the West Chester Historic District* (available at the Borough Hall)
- Projects located in the Borough of West Chester Historic District require a Certificate of Appropriateness (COA) from the Borough Council prior to receiving a Building Permit; Please submit a copy of the COA approval letter with your nomination

Preservation Service Award

- Eligible projects include but are not limited to events, tours, workshops, lectures, publications, and data collection/cataloging projects
- Briefly describe the project and how it contributed to the appreciation of West Chester's history and promoted its historic preservation
- Describe any special goals or challenges addressed during the project
- Provide relevant program documents (if available) and copies of published projects
- Project must have been completed after January 1, 2001
