

ORDINANCE NO. 13 -2020

BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER

CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 104 TITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", SECTION 104-32 TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE EAST SIDE OF N. BRANDYWINE STREET ON WEDNESDAY 8:00AM-11:00AM FROM W. GAY STREET TO W. CHESTNUT STREET AND ON THE WEST SIDE OF N. BRANDYWINE STREET ON THURSDAY FROM 8:00AM-11:00AM FROM W. GAY STRET TO W. CHESTNUT STREET AND SECTION 104-88 TO REPLACE THE BOND REQUIREMENT FOR GARAGES THAT STORE IMPOUNDED VEHICLES WITH A REQUIREMENT TO OBTAIN GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE AND GARAGEKEEPERS INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it hereby enacted by authority of the Council of the Borough of West Chester, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 104 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled, "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 104-32, titled, "Parking prohibited during certain hours" is hereby amended **TO ADD** the following:

Highway	Side	Days/Hours	Location
N. Brandywine St.	East	Wednesday 8:00am-11:00am	W. Gay St to W. Chestnut St.
N. Brandywine St.	West	Thursday 8:00am-11:00am	W. Gay St. to W. Chestnut St.

SECTION 2. Chapter 104 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled, "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 104-88 titled "Garages to post bond" shall be revised to read as follows:

"§ 104-88. Garages to provide certificates of insurance.

Every such approved storage garage shall provide current certificates of insurance, demonstrating general liability coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000, and garage keeper's coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000, to be filed with the Borough Secretary."


SECTION 3. SERVABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council of the Borough of West Chester that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included therein.

SECTION 4. REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment as provided by law.
