The design consists of a fictional young women's portrait, which is depicted in a geometric style. Her eyes are closed, and 2 pairs of hands are shown just below her face. The image is emotional and expresses the spirit of the Friends Association's mission. The figure is surrounded by a cloud-like structure. Symbols float around, some abstract and some portraying housing and family. Some of the background elements may turn the corner onto the south facing façade.
